The braille dot produced by ViewPlus embossers can be adjusted in height, allowing users to adjust to the individual sensibility of the reader's fingertip. This makes extended braille reading more enjoyable, while maintaining unsurpassed detail in producing tactile graphics. The unique shape of the ViewPlus dot is proven to make braille more durable, thus allowing documents to last longer over time.

ViewPlus solutions include Windows printer drivers that will allow embossing directly from Windows programs, utilizing the same process as printing to mainstream color printers. Additionally, direct printing from braille notetakers is also supported.

What you see on the screen is what ViewPlus embossers will print, representing the color spectrum from white to black in 7 different heights of the embossed dots.

The Elite is also available with InkConnect, which adds single-sided black ink text and overprints on tactile graphics to your braille documents allowing sighted users to read along.

All ViewPlus embossers are compatible with other braille translation software, including Duxbury, Braille2000, and RTFC. However, we proudly offer the Tiger Software Suite (TSS) for braille translation, tactile graphics design, and more — at no additional cost with any ViewPlus embosser purchase. With TSS, users can seamlessly create braille documents in widely used Windows programs like MS Word and Excel, even without in-depth braille expertise.

Included in the TSS package is Tiger Designer, a tactile graphics editor that empowers users to edit print data visualized on-screen, ensuring it aligns flawlessly with the embossed output.
